The Lezser Red Cuvée is a combination that pairs the lighter Portugieser (70-80%) with the more pronounced Blaufrankisch. This combination results in a wine that is very fruity, fragrant, and easy to drink. It is highly sought after by the gastronomic market.

The wine is a rightfully successful conception belonging to the fantastically named "Lezser" (literally easy-going) wine family. It is the White Cuvée's red older brother.
