Vineyard

- Age of vines: 17 years
- Vineyard: Alsónána plateau, south facing slopes
- Training system: cordon
- Grape variety: Kékfrankos
- Soil: loess
- Yield: 1,5 kg
- Winemaker: Csaba Sebestyén

Harvest

- Harvest: October 2019

Winemaking

- Hand picked grapes were selected
- Fermented in open tanks between 27-30 C, then macerated for 7 days,
- Aged for 14 months in used Hungarian and French 5hl oak barrels

- Bottled: Februar 2021
- Number of bottles: 1700
- Residual sugar: 1,7 g/l
- Extract: 28 g/l
- Alcohol: 13 %
- Acidity: 5,3 g/l

Kékfrankos, known outside Hungary as Blaufrankisch, produces characterful wines with deep fruits and smooth tannins. It is a well balanced wine with lingering flavours of red berries and spices. Thank to the cooler plateau of Nána vineyard, this wine is built on its elegant acidity. It is a great expression of the feminine side of the variety.
