Description Kékfrankos (also known as

Blaufränkisch) is the most planted black grape variety in Hungary and is a must try wine of Central Europe. It is thought to have originated in Lower Styria, which is now a part of Slovenia. It has its own personality, a true 'hungaricum'. An extremely versatile wine: it can be consumed young – then it is full of sour cherry and other red fruits -, but it is suitable for barrel ageing as well. Teleki Villányi Kékfrankos follows the lighter, frutier path though it is matured in large wooden cask for a while, which makes it more full bodied, more complex. On the palate it feels almost velvety, and its aftertaste lingers on for a long time in our mouth. An ideal match with dishes made of duck breast and perfect with typical Hungarian dishes.
