

## Iván-valley Bikavér

Szekszárd / 2020



### Vineyard

- Age of vines: 8-73 years, old vine Kadarka
- Vineyard: Iván-valley
- Training system: bush, cordon, guyot
- Grape variety: 57% Kékfrankos, 15% Merlot, 12% Cabernet Franc, 9% Kadarka, 7% Cabernet Sauvignon
- Soil: loess with calcareous 'dolls'
- Yield: 1-1,5 kg/vine
- Winemaker: Csaba Sebestyén

### Harvest

- Harvest: September and October 2020

### Winemaking

- Hand picked grapes were selected
- Fermented between 28-30 °C for 8 days, then macerated between 2-7 days
- Aged for 22 months in Hungarian and French used oak barrels
  
- Bottled: January 2023
- Number of bottles: 3200
- Residual sugar: 1,5 g/l
- Extract: 28,3 g/l
- Alcohol: 13,5 %
- Acidity: 5,1 g/l

It is our family's dream of create a single-vineyard bikavér that reflects the soil of terroir, the grape varieties and the tradition of the region. It shows notes of spices, like cloves and liquorice, together with subtle aromas of red and dark berries. Grapes are hand harvested from old vines, giving it an exceptionally layered character.
