Vineyard

- Age of vines: 5 years
- Vineyard: Porkoláb
- Training system: cordon, guyot
- Grape variety: Kékfrankos
- Soil: loess with high content of lime
- Yield: 1,5 kg/vine
- Winemaker: Csaba Sebestyén

Harvest

- Harvest: September 2021

Winemaking

- Hand picked grapes were selected
- Fermented between 27-29 °C for 8 days, then macerated between 2-7 days
- Aged for 22 months in 5hl used Hungarian oak barrels

- Bottled: August 2023
- Number of bottles: 1200
- Residual sugar: 1,3 g/l
- Extract: 27 g/l
- Alcohol: 14 %
- Acidity: 4,9 g/l

Tons of summer-flower, cherry and plum character is married to gentle tannins on the moderately rich palate, the lively acidity carrying this beautifully on the silky texture.
