Summary of the winemaker

"For us, the Apukám Világa is more than just a wine. It's a story that recalls the spirit of our family. A batch that pays homage to the great old wines of Badacsony and to our father, Dr. József Laposa. This wine represents the great wines of old, with higher alcohol, full-bodied, ripe flavours and an unmistakable softness typical of Badacsony. We try to show the potential of the production area. These types of wines are released after several years of ageing, because this is when the secondary and tertiary flavours become fully developed," says Dr. József Laposa. From the Badacsony side, the grapes come from the most beautiful micro-terraces. It has notes of ripe fruit on the nose, with vanilla notes from barrel ageing and an almond flavour typical of the variety. The colour is straw yellow, with peach and buttery notes. It is characterised by minerality and saltiness, in addition to the typical oak barrel notes.

Winemaking notes

This Welschriesling was harvested at full maturity in mid-October 2023. A very nice, complex material arrived in the cellar thanks to the long summer of old age. For the 2023 vintage, 100% of the entire lot was fermented and matured in oak barrels. After bottling, we waited another 9 months before presenting it. During the vinification process, we aimed to show the classic face of Welschriesling.
