Winemaker's Summary

"The Kápolna Welschriesling is part of our outstanding single-vineyard series, and this grape variety truly deserves its place here. It perfectly expresses the exceptional terroir of Mount Csobánc. Its aroma is restrained, mineral-driven, and slowly unfolding, while its flavors linger long after tasting. The grapes used for this wine were grown next to the Saint Donát Chapel on Mount Csobánc.

The name 'Kápolnás wine' has traditionally represented unique and outstanding quality in the Badacsony wine region."

Wine & Food Pairing

In line with the wine's serious character, it pairs beautifully with slow-cooked pork or even beef dishes, accompanied by richer, heartier side dishes.

Winemaking Notes

After identifying the perfect harvest date, excellent-quality grapes arrived at the cellar, harvested at full ripeness. Fermentation took place in large oak casks, followed by six months of barrel aging before bottling. The wine was released in the autumn of 2020. If anything, this is truly a terroir-driven wine.

Csobánc is an untouched witness hill located north of Gulács. Our vineyard on its southern slope provides the grapes for this wine. The site is characterized by highly diverse soils: beneath the basaltic loam, both limestone and basalt layers have formed, clearly visible across the area.

Analysis

- Grape variety: 100% Welschriesling
- Fermentation: 100% in large oak casks
- Aging: 50% aged for 8 months in large oak casks
- Style: Dry
- Alcohol: 13%
- Residual sugar: 0.9 g/L
- Total acidity: 4.8 g/L
