Winemaker's summary

"A grape variety derived from a cross between Ezerjó and Bouvier. It has good sugar content and pronounced acidity, making it ideal for late harvest wines. Its aroma reveals a multitude of dried fruits, mixed with a hint of pronounced coolness. It is an extremely flavorful wine with high extract content. It can be aged for a long time."

Winemaking notes

After finding the perfect harvest time, excellent raw materials arrived at the cellar after being harvested at full ripeness. The 2024 vintage was bottled in April and hit the shelves in the spring.
