The 2017 vintage in Tokaj was warm and generous, allowing healthy ripeness and well-developed botrytis. The result is a rich yet balanced sweet Szamorodni with depth and elegance.

In the glass, the wine shows a deep golden color with an oily, slow movement. It needs a few seconds to open; gentle aeration reveals an expressive nose of dried apricot, tangerine and orange, alongside ripe apple. Characteristic botrytis notes emerge: subtle mushroom and earthy nuances adding complexity.

On the palate, it is silky and smooth, with dried fruit flavors mirroring the aromas. Honey and ripe pear broaden the profile, complemented by hints of sugared apple. The texture is round and harmonious, supported by a fine structure that carries the wine to a long, refined finish.
