Winemaker's summary

"Zenit is a Hungarian white grape variety. It is prone to botrytis, and its wine is pleasant and rich in flavors. Its aroma features elderflower and almost bite-sized tropical fruits. The aroma is harmoniously reflected in the taste, with juicy peach, ripe yellow apple, a hint of Williams pear and mint. The residual sugar content provides a perfect balance with its round acids, and it could become your favorite wine of the summer. The perfect choice for warm summer evenings sailing on your yacht.

Winemaking notes

Our Zenit, harvested in early September, came to the cellar mainly from our Badacsony vineyards and several areas on the northern shore of Lake Balaton. It is made using 100% tank fermentation and reductive methods, which preserve the wine's freshness and aroma.
